Step-by-Step with Modern Masters

HOLIDAY | Lettered Metallic Mason Jars



STEP 1: Decide which word or lettering you'd prefer on your jars and design that amount of mason jars to paint. On the glass jars, brush on a suitable acrylic bonding primer to prep the glass mason jars.

STEP 2: Since choosing the word 'Family', there were six jars to paint. Pick your favorite Metallic Paint colors and brush on 2 - 3 coats, letting each layer dry fully. I used Sapphire Metallic Paint for the F, Copper Metallic Paint for the A, Teal Metallic Paint for the M, Olympic Gold for the I, Antique Copper for the L, Hunter Green Metallic Paint for the Y.

STEP 3: While the Metallic Paint coats are drying, create a page of letters to fit your mason jar fronts. I used the CopperPlate Bold at 151 and printed the letters from a Cricut. You can also purchase ready-made letters from your local craft store.

STEP 4: Using a piece of double stick tape, adhere a letter to each jar. Add pretty flowers and line the jars up on a mantle or shelf.

You are done!
